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Dr. Miller shared the Student Safety meeting that will be held March 26, 2019 from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

On motion by Claire Lang, seconded by Trey Newell, the Board unanimously approved the Metro Power contract in the amount of \$269,417.00 for LCHS LED lighting project for football stadium. The project will be funded with SPLOST bond funds.

On motion by Donna Ford, seconded by Sylvia Vann, the Board unanimously approved grades 9-12 summer school guidelines.

On motion by Sylvia Vann, seconded by Trey Newell, the Board unanimously appointed Donna Ford as Legislative Delegate and Claire Lang as Alternate Delegate to the 2019 GSBA Delegate Assembly in Savannah, Georgia.

GSBA Legislative Positions proposal process was discussed.
